



# Langley Rep Fastpitch Player Try-Out Protocol

**What to bring:** ball gear, hand sanitizer, mask, and full water bottle.

**Before Try-Outs Begins** – we suggest leaving lots of time to get checked in as the process will be longer than normal.

1. Players are to be dropped off by parents to check-in. Parents are to remain in their vehicle.  
\*\*Exception: 2010's are able to bring their parent to check-in. \*\*
2. Check in will happen at the concession building on the west side of the parking lot off of 36<sup>th</sup> Ave at Noel Booth Park.
3. Check-in will be separated by team. Please make sure you line up in the correct area.
4. Please ensure you are wearing a mask for the check-in process.
5. Use markers to maintain your 6 feet distance from other players checking in.
6. Check-in will include Attendance Tracking and Screening of each player.
7. Please be prepared to answer the following questions:
  - a) Are you exhibiting any symptoms of COVID-19 (fever, dry cough, chest or respiratory pain?)
  - b) Has any member of your household exhibited any symptoms of COVID-19 within the last 14 days?
  - c) Have you or any other member of your household arrived from outside Canada in the past 14 days?
  - d) Do you agree to 100% comply with Langley Rep Fastpitch's specific Return to Play guidelines including but not limited to, no spectators allowed, social distancing, and sanitation rules?
8. Players must be pre-registered and have submitted their COVID waivers prior to arriving at the park in order to participate in the Try-Outs. **Walk ups will not be allowed on the field.**

## After Check-In

1. Players are to walk over to their appropriate diamond.
2. 2010's can have a parent walk them over to the diamond but then must return to their car.
3. **No Spectators are allowed, as per the Township of Langley. Parents spectating will be asked to pick up their child from the diamond and leave the try-out immediately. No exceptions.**

## After Try-Outs

1. Return pinnies to the bin at the diamond.
2. Return immediately to your car and leave the park as soon as possible. Parents are to pick up at the Egress point for the specific diamond. \*\*Exception: 2010 parents may collect players from the diamond but are not to arrive more than 10 minutes before the end of the try-out. Time TBA\*\*
